<p><u>Membership Fee:</u></p> <p>This pays for ongoing team expenses: USWP team membership/insurance, PO Box, Web site, etc.</p>	<p>\$30 per year</p> <p>Memberships run from January – December. Memberships billed after Sept. 1 will be effective through the following year.</p>	<p>None</p>
<p><u>Practice Fees:</u></p> <p>This pays for pool costs: pool time, lifeguard and/or building supervisor</p>	<p>Option 1: \$10 per practice</p> <p>Option 2*: \$40 prepaid month</p> <p>Option 3*: \$100 prepaid for Jan.-Mar. * Prepaid fees do not carry over (i.e. If you pay for Sept. and miss practices, the money will not carry-over to cover future practices.)

^ Year goes from January 1 to December 31. The \$30 membership fee is included in the prepaid year fee.

Check	<p>Make checks payable to “<i>Seattle Otters.</i>” Checks can be handed to the team secretary or treasurer at any practice. <u>Checks can also be mailed to:</u> Seattle Otters 1122 E Pike St. #1115 Seattle, WA 98122</p> <p>NOTE: Be aware that checks are turned into the business manager once a month, so there may be some time delay before the checks clear.</p>
Cash	<p>Cash can be handed to the team secretary or treasurer at any practice.</p>
